- The names, affiliation, email address, telephone, and fax numbers of all co-authors on the cover page. The designated contact author should also be identified.
- A statement of the purpose and importance of the research.
- A brief review of the literature.
- Planned methodology and any preliminary results.

Doctoral students who make a presentation receive a registration fee waiver. In addition, doctoral students who present a paper are encouraged to apply for the Mark Dorfman Doctoral Student Award, which is a competitive travel reimbursement award.
